## REGULAR SCHOOL DAY DRESS CODE

### MALE STUDENTS

#### TOPS:

All male students must wear an appropriately sized logoed Justin-Siena polo or button down shirt (short or long sleeved) exclusively available from the Lands' End online store. A variety of color choices are available.

#### BOTTOMS:

Male students may only wear **blue colored jeans** or **chino-style/docker style trousers of khaki or navy color**. Pants must fit appropriately in length and size. Male students may also wear **khaki or navy colored shorts** purchased through the Lands' End online store. No other shorts are allowed.

### FEMALE STUDENTS

#### TOPS:

All female students must wear an appropriately sized logoed Justin-Siena polo or button down shirt (short or long sleeved) exclusively available from the Lands' End online store. A variety of color choices are available.

#### BOTTOMS:

As well as the pants described above, if desired, female students may wear an official Justin-Siena skirt/skort available online through Lands' End. Skirts **may not** be folded or altered in length. A variety of official skirt styles and colors are available through the Lands' End online store.

### ALL STUDENTS:

#### OUTERWEAR:

Sweatshirts, hoodies, pullovers, and zip up jackets may be worn, but **must have a Justin-Siena logo**. When wearing outerwear it must be worn with a Justin-Siena polo or button down shirt underneath. Many options will be available through our online Braves wear store. When weather conditions require, students may also wear non-Justin-Siena solid colored insulated jackets if appropriate, neat, and modest but must be worn with a Justin-Siena polo or button down shirt underneath and visible at all times.

#### SHOES:

Appropriate shoes are to be worn at all times during the school day. All shoes/sandals must have a back that covers the back of the foot. Shoes with heels must not exceed 3 inches. Flip-flop style shoes (and sandals worn without the back strap across the back of the heel), slippers, and shoes with rollers are not allowed.

#### HATS:

Head coverings may be worn provided that they have a Justin-Siena logo only. These may not be worn in class or inside any of the buildings during school hours. The Dean has the discretion to alter this policy for religious purposes.



**GROOMING:**

Students' hair should be neatly groomed and not cut in extreme styles. No facial hair is permitted. Only studded or small hoop earrings are acceptable.

**BODY ADORNMENT:**

Makeup must be in good taste and not excessive. Visible tattoos are not acceptable.

**ATHLETIC TEAM COMPETITION DAYS:**

Members of athletic teams may wear approved tops and or jerseys on competition days with **the approval of the Coach, the Athletic Director, and the Dean**; all other criteria of the dress code apply (e.g., a basketball player may not wear basketball shorts). All members of a specific team will wear the same outfit.

**AFTER SCHOOL DRESS:**

Students are expected to remain in dress code except while at sports practice or games.

**DRESS UP DAY DRESS CODE**

**MALE STUDENTS:**

Male students must wear a Justin-Siena logoed white button-down shirt (purchased through Lands' End), a tie, **khaki colored chino-style/docker-style pants**, black or brown belt, and dress shoes (e.g. non-athletic shoes).

**FEMALE STUDENTS:**

Female students must wear a Justin-Siena logoed white button-down shirt, **khaki colored chino-style pants** or the approved Justin-Siena skirts (available through Lands' End).

**ALL STUDENTS:**

For outerwear, all students may only wear a vest, sweater, or jacket **with a visible Justin-Siena logo**. These items are available through Lands' End. Sweatshirts, hoodies, and pullover jackets are not allowed on Dress-up days.

**\*ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN DRESS CODE FOR ORIENTATION ON AUGUST 17, 2016 AND THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES ON AUGUST 18, 2016. PLEASE PLACE YOUR LANDS' END ORDERS IN ANTICIPATION OF THOSE DATES. DRESS UP DAY ATTIRE WILL BE NEEDED BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2016.\***
