# COMMUNITY PROFILE

Stoney Creek is a community in the city of Hamilton in the Canadian province of Ontario. It is close to local attractions including the Art Gallery of Hamilton, Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum, HMCS Haida National Historic Site, Dundurn Castle, Royal Botanical Gardens, Canadian Football Hall of Fame, African Lion Safari Park, Workers' Arts and Heritage Centre, and the Hamilton Museum of Steam & Technology. Tourists enjoy visiting Albion Falls, a 62 ft classical/cascade waterfall flowing down the Niagara Escarpment in Red Hill Valley, in Hamilton which offers scenic views. Nearby sites include Eramosa Karst Conservation Area, Fifty Point Conservation Area, and Battlefield House Museum & Park.
