St. Catharines is the largest city in Canada's Niagara Region and the sixth largest urban area in the province of Ontario. Manufacturing is the city's dominant industry. St. Catharines carries the official nickname "The Garden City" due to its 1,000 acres of parks, gardens, and trails including Lakeside Park, Montebello Park, Burgoyne Woods, Ontario Jaycee Gardens, and Walker Arboretum. Rich in culture, St. Catharines is home to a number of notable art institutions including the CRAM Collective and the Niagara Artists Centre, as well as a variety of theatre companies including Garden City Productions, Carousel Players, Mirror Theatre, and the FirstOntario Performing Arts Centre.
