COMMUNITY PROFILE

Collingwood is a town located in Ontario, about a two-hour drive northwest of Toronto. Its harbour is in Nottawasaga Bay. The city is a gateway to the Blue Mountain ski resort with its downhill and cross-country trails. Downtown Collingwood features historic buildings that now house chic boutiques, quaint stores, and an eclectic mix of restaurants and cafes. The town center is marked by the beaux arts-style Collingwood Federal Building. The Collingwood Museum's exhibits highlight Collingwood Harbour's shipbuilding history. Tourists enjoy visiting nearby Blue Mountain Village, the Scenic Caves, as well as the Downtown Farmers' Market. It offers an ideal mix of history, charm, food, shopping, and culture.
