Midland is a town located on the Georgian Bay in Simcoe County, Ontario. In the summer months, the area's population grows to over 100,000 with seasonal visitors to more than 8,000 cottages, resort hotels, and provincial and national parks in the surrounding areas. Cultural points of interest include Martyrs' Shrine, Sainte-Marie Among the Hurons historic site, Midland Murals and Cultural Centre, Huronia Museum & Owendat Village, Cathy Boyd Fine Art Gallery, and the Wye Marsh Wildlife Centre.
