COMMUNITY PROFILE

Newmarket is a town in the municipality of York in Ontario, Canada. It is part of Greater Toronto in the Golden Horseshoe region of Southern Ontario. Landmarks include Upper Canada Mall, Southlake Regional Health Centre, the Main Street Heritage Conservation District, and Wesley Brooks Conservation Area. The NewRoads Performing Arts Centre is the largest performing arts theatre in the town, with a capacity of 400. It hosts a selection of world-class artists and local performing arts events annually. Numerous buildings and sites located in Newmarket possess a high degree of historical significance. Newmarket is also home to the York Curling Club, several hockey teams, and 3 public swimming pools.
