King City is an unincorporated Canadian community in the township of King, Ontario located north of Toronto. A culturally rich city, highlights include the King Heritage & Cultural Centre which houses the King Township Historical Society, Arts Society King, the township archives and museum collection, as well as two exhibition galleries, a performance hall, and four historic buildings. King City is also home to San Lorenzo Park, a 200-acre park facility with an RV campground, playgrounds, volleyball courts, horseshoe pits, a softball area, numerous picnic areas and beautiful hiking trails, as well as King City Trail, a 1.7 mile trail that offers the chance to see wildlife and is good for all skill levels.
