COMMUNITY PROFILE

Maple is an urban community in Vaughan, in the York Region of Ontario. It is located northwest of Toronto. Maple is near the David Dunlap Observatory telescope, the largest telescope in Canada. Area highlights include the Vaughan Metropolitan Centre which is a new 442-acre central business district under development, Boyd Conservation Area, Kortright Centre for Conservation, and the McMichael Canadian Art Collection. Local sites include Legoland Discovery Centre and Reptilia Zoo, a 25,000 square foot Reptile Zoo and Education Centre located near Vaughan Mills, a large shopping mall opened in 2004 and Canada's Wonderland, Canada's largest amusement park.
